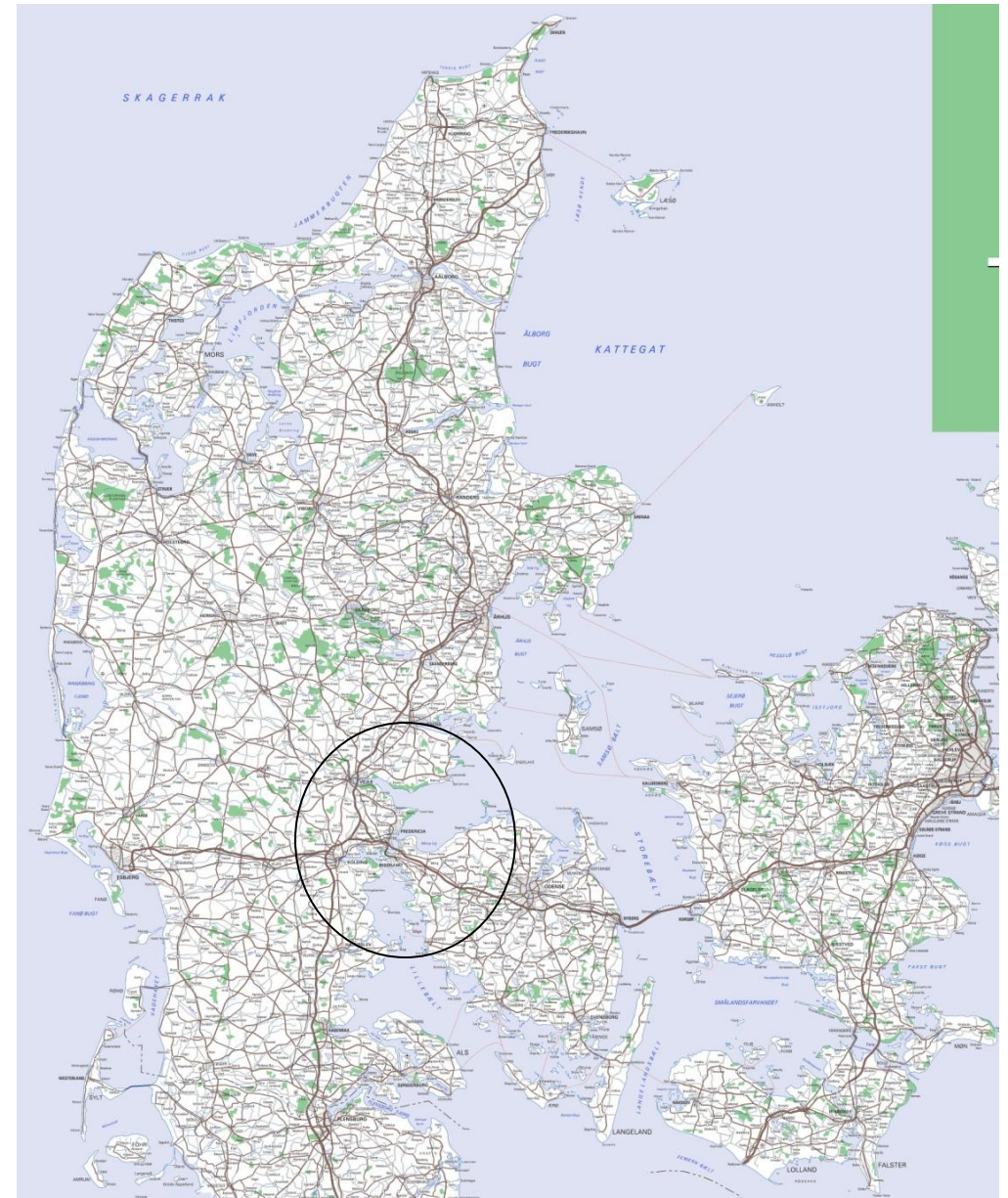


A Danish approach to North Sea SEP

- Together the Green Network partners work to achieve greater sustainability.
- The 5 municipalities in Green Network are all sub-partners in the North Sea SEP.

- Kolding

Middle-sized municipalities: 45.000 – 102.000 inhabitants.

All situated in one of Denmark's growth areas, the Triangle Region.



CO₂ baseline for municipalities



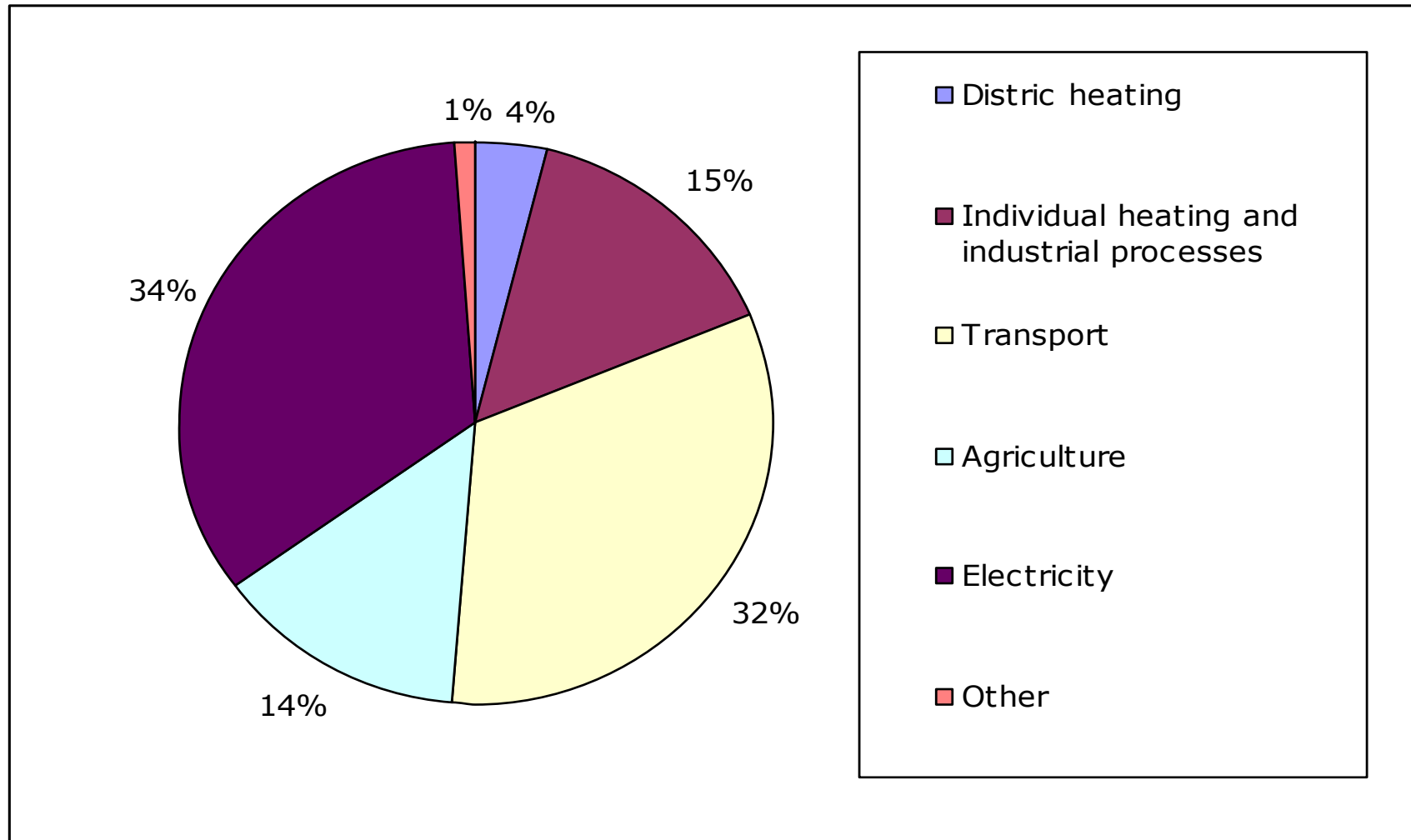
One of the main sub-projects for the Danish sub-partners is to complete a CO₂ baseline for the municipality.

The CO₂ baseline provides an overview of all the emissions in the geographical area.

The emissions are calculated by collecting data from all sectors.

The overview can then be used for prioritizing the climate effort.

CO₂ baseline for Kolding Municipality



- The CO₂ baseline is based on 2007 data

- Updated every second year



Kolding's use of CO₂ baseline



- Within the 5 effort areas – the citizens, construction & buildings, transport, business and the municipality itself, activities are prioritized.

Some examples:

- Energysupply planning
- Citizen involvement, especially around electricity savings
- Sustainable transportplan
